ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

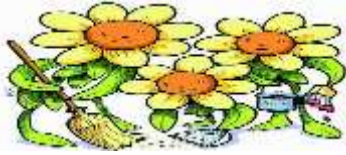
