The PNU also issues tax deferred Annuities. An Annuity allows an individual to make periodic contributions and in return offers tax deferred (not tax free) growth of earnings, a death benefit

paid to a named beneficiary or a guaranteed distribution of income over a fixed period or until the death of the Insured. The initial payment to start an annuity is \$1,000.
