Church: Home for Wounded Hearts

The Church, the home for the wounded hearts, we mean the Body of Christ, that is present in every local congregation, like the parish, like the diocese, or society, and most especially, the family, the home, the domestic church, the church in the family.

Being the Body of Christ, the Church shares in Jesus' mission of proclaiming the reign of God through healing, through solidarity, through compassion. Saint Paul says, in his First Letter to the Corinthians, Chapter 12: "If one member suffers, all the members suffer with it. If one member is honored, all the members share its joy."

The Church of wounded members becomes a Church of solidarity and compassion, in union with each other. Not only in glory but most especially in wounds.

Dear parents, when your child, your son or daughter will graduate with honors, I always hear this, the remark of parent, as he or she witnesses the event, with tears in his or her eyes, he will say: "Oh, my son! My daughter!"

But when the child does not pass the course, and is required to repeat the course, one parent will address his or her spouse, and say: "Hey, your son! Your son must repeat the course!" How come when it is about honor, it's "my" child. When it is a disaster, it is "your" child. We are one Church, one home, one family. The Church must embody the redemptive mission of God.

The Church is the sacrament, the sign and instrument, of the intimate union between God and humanity, and of human beings among themselves. That's at the core of the Church intimate union, communion, love, and not alienation. So at the very core of the Church's identity is its mission, you are not there to alienate further. You are there to heal, to unite, and to reconcile. That's the Church. No one gives up! I won't give up! We won't give up leading people to the healing touch of Jesus.

In the words of Maria Cataldo Cunniff, the Church opens doors to Jesus, and sometimes roofs in order to bring people to Jesus. **Fr. Nadeem Yaqoob**
