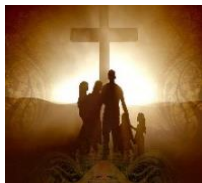

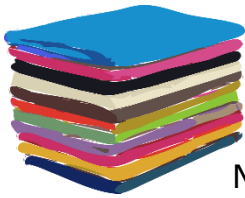
CHOPIN SINGING SOCIETY 118th CONCERT
