Blank forms are available in the vestibule. Please return completed forms to Chris Giczkowski by **Sunday, June 4.**

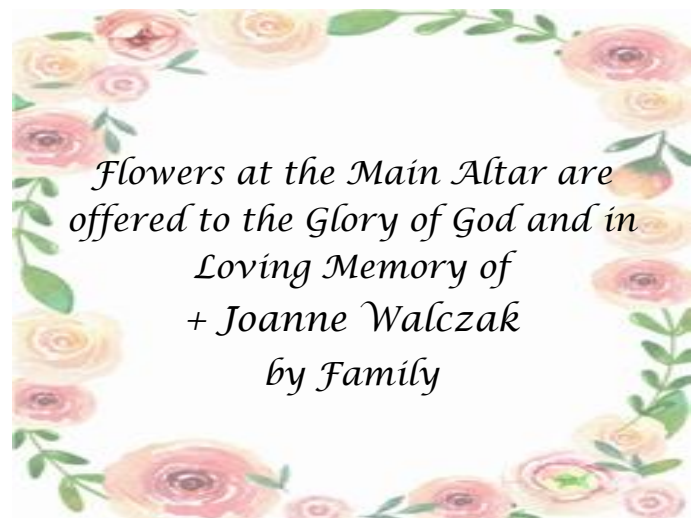


