Saturday March 13th



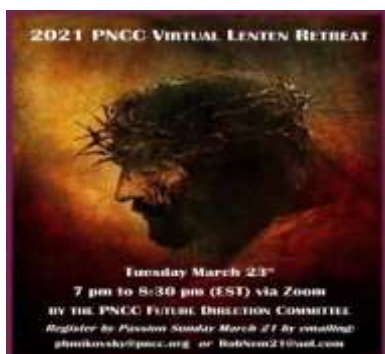
