#### **Veterans Day Mass**



# Reflection for the 32<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

We must live by the obedience of faith, a faith that shows itself in works of charity and self-sacrifice. That's the lesion of the two widows in today's liturgy. The widow in the first reading trusts in the word of Elijah and the promise of his Lord. Facing sure starvation, she gives all that she has, her last bit of food—feeding the man of God before herself and her family. This woman most likely didn't know that Elijah was a prophet.

The widow in the Gospel also gives all that she has, offering her last bit of money to support the work of God's priests in the Temple. Jesus gave all He had to redeem mankind, and we are called to imitate His sacrifice of love in our own lives. We will be judged, but not by how much we give—for the scribes and the wealthy contribute far more than the widow. Rather, we will be judged by whether our gifts reflect our livelihood, our whole beings, all our heart and soul, mind and strength.

Today, let us follow the widows' example, doing what God asks, confident that our jars of flour will not grow empty, nor our jugs of oil run dry.
