Adult Bible Study

If you are interested in the mysterious Book of Revelation, come join our Bible Study on Sunday mornings. We are beginning our study on the Book of Revelation, which goes by other names such as The Revelation to John and the Apocalypse of John. It was written by the apostle John, son of Zebedee, on an island between Greece and modern-day Turkey, likely around 90 AD. We are using a Catholic study guide to help us better understand this very complicated writing. It is difficult to comprehend because it is written in the apocalyptic style of the day using numbers, symbols, angels, and fantastic beasts imagery. We will get into topics such as the "End Times," Jesus' second coming, the Anti-Christ, the final battle of Armageddon, and "the New Heavens and New Earth." If you want to better understand the mysteries of this book, the very last book in the Bible, come grab a cup of coffee and a delicious roll or baked good, and we'll get through this together.
