Please join us for Ash Wednesday on March 5 this year. Masses will be at 9:00 AM and 7:00 PM.

PENANCE: A REALITY CHECK

Penance is a recognition that 1) something is wrong in our lives, and 2) we cannot save ourselves. Just as we have freely done wrong, we can freely offer penance as a sign of our own change of heart as well as our desire for God's grace.

Rather than a set of mechanical actions meant to win us God's favor, penance focuses our attention on the place God has in our lives and the love we can express toward one another.

The Catholic faith is *incarnational*, meaning that it is embodied in concrete actions. Penitential practices are ways of making concrete our love of God and of neighbor.

LENTEN PENITENTIAL REGULATIONS

Fasting: All Catholics in good health from age 18 to 59 fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by limiting themselves to one full meal each day. On such fast days, they may also take two smaller meals, but nothing between meals.

Abstinence: Catholics aged 14 and older abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.
